DEQAR Aim & Objectives



 Aim: collect all external quality assurance reports and decisions performed by EQAR-registered agencies in line with the ESG in a European one-stop shop.

• Objectives:

- 1) Improve access to information on the external QA
- 2) Facilitate the recognition of qualifications
- 3) Map the diversity of external QA frameworks
- 4) Facilitate exchange of data and links with other tools

Background to Project

- Idea for DEQAR has existed ever since EQAR founded in 2008, but gained traction with automatic recognition policy goal
- Decision to go ahead by EQAR GA in 2017, launch in 2018 (Paris Ministerial Conference)

- DEQAR CONNECT: widen coverage and enhance connectivity
 - Erasmus+ funding to support the EHEA key commitments
 - Project lifetime: March 2020 February 2022

Specific Goals & Objectives



- Strand 1: widen coverage to new agencies & countries
 - create an impetus for QA agencies that have not yet received support through the initial DEQAR project
 - provide peer support and counselling to agencies
 - implement efficient methods for submitting data to DEQAR
- Strand 2: enhance connectivity and explore new opportunities
 - integrate DEQAR information in the recognition/credential evaluation
 - enable the use of DEQAR data for the Europass Accreditation Database
 - explore further opportunities to connect
- Transversal:
 - support the activities of the BFUG Thematic Peer Groups (TPG)
 - enhance DEQAR's visibility and relevance among all stakeholders

 Milestone: completed by Feb 2021
- Implementation of Submission API client or CSV export Milestones: uploads by Aug 2021, completed by Nov 2021
- Pilot use of DEQAR to feed QA agencies' own website

- Integrate QA information in ENIC-NARIC workflows
 Milestones: at least two integrations by Feb 2021, all four finished by May 2021
 Covid-19: workshop postponed, additional webinar today
- Implement compatibility layers that will allow the use of DEQAR data for Europass Digital Credentials
- Roundtable with higher education data initiatives to discuss potential for connectivity and interoperability
- Review and enhance DEQAR data model and API to enhance interoperability

Design Principles




- Lean approach: only what is needed and readily available
- Standardised: Institutional level as starting point
- Comprehensive and up-to-date: include all currently valid reports/reviews within the scope of the ESG
- Accessible and understandable: use of English; contextual information provided to clarify the status of reports and activities
- Low entry barrier for agencies: different submission methods to cater for different agencies; all methods/code made public
- Free and open access to public: no fees or restrictions on use; available as "open data" through data dump or public search API





DEQAR Web API



- REST API that gives access to all data in DEQAR
 - Institutions
 - QA reports
 - Countries
 - Agencies
- Exact same API as used by public DEQAR web interface









- Available to anyone interested
- Free of charge, but subject to prior registration
 - Granted unless we have reasons to believe that the information might be abused or misrepresented
