## Overall Messages



- EQAR is excellent in fulfilling its original mandate
- Develop action plan on how to best support relevant new developments and address new challenges in EHEA from the QA perspective

### Mission & Governance



- Fitness for purpose: excellent
- Governance model & stakeholder engagement: fine
  - Introduction of President is positive
  - Members' Dialogue is an excellent forum
  - Reflect on governance, but relish strong stakeholder representation

#### Resources



- Staff and resources: highly engaged, competent and proactive staff
  - Invest in further professional development
  - Develop a clear resource plan

## ESG Compliance



- Internal policies and processes: in general fine
  - Try to shorten length of reviews
  - Shorten time for consideration of appeals
  - Clearer policies and procedures for substantive change reports
  - Reflect on the Use & Interpretation of ESG
  - Evaluate the new "targeted reviews"

# Strategic Plan



- Transparency and Information
  - See DEQAR (sheet 9)
  - See policy contribution (sheet 6)
- International Trust and Recognition
  - EQAR contributes to these goals
  - Consider more direct contact with governments
  - Find incentives for cross-border accreditation and cooperation
